
SECURITY CONTROL

IMPORTANT RULES

1. There may be a high volume of visitors at the Museum.

It may get crowded and difficult to navigate in-between other visitors.

2. It may get noisy at the Museum.

You may use ear defenders available at the ticket desk.

3. Don't talk loudly, it may disturb other visitors.

4. Listen to the instructions of the Museum staff.

5. You have to be at least 12 years of age to visit the Holocaust Gallery.


