

## Rules of the event

### "Children's Day. A journey to the land of emotions"

(hereinafter: "Regulations")

1. The event is educational and artistic.
2. The event takes place on May 28, 2023 from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

**The organizer of the event is the POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews, Anielewicza 6, 00-157 Warsaw, phone no. 22 471 03 01, [www.polin.pl](http://www.polin.pl); e-mail: [polin@polin.pl](mailto:polin@polin.pl).**

3. The condition for using the event is to read the following Regulations and comply with them. Failure to comply with the following Regulations may result in calling the appropriate security services to remove the participant of the event or take other actions to stop the violation of the Regulations.
4. Entering the area where the event takes place is tantamount to accepting the Regulations. Acceptance of the Regulations is necessary to use the event.
5. The event is open to the public and its use is free of charge. Minors may use the event only in the presence of an adult guardian, who is also responsible for damages and accidents caused by himself and by minors under his care.
6. The event consists of the following activities (hereinafter: "events"): family workshops in the form of a game, family animations. Persons participating in the event are obliged to comply with the orders and instructions issued by the persons conducting the events on the part of the Organizer.
7. Animals may stay at the event area only under the care of the owner and at his responsibility and risk, provided that they do not hinder the use of the event.

8. Persons under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other similar substances are prohibited from staying at the event area. It is also forbidden to consume alcoholic beverages, intoxicants or other drugs with a similar effect at the event.
9. Smoking, bringing in any dangerous materials or objects, in particular weapons, firecrackers, sparklers, flares, knives and open fire are strictly prohibited in the event area.
10. There is a total ban on littering and leaving food or drink remains at the event site.
11. Please be advised that during the event photos will be taken and videos will be recorded, which will be made public on the Museum's social media (e.g. Facebook, Instagram), on the Museum's website, for promotional purposes of the Museum and in connection with the implementation of statutory obligations, i.e. supporting and conduct artistic and culture-disseminating activities, including e.g. organizing concerts, performances, public discussions and film and multimedia screenings.
12. It is forbidden to engage in any obscene behavior, use offensive language, announce and display slogans with obscene, vulgar, racist or other content that violate or may violate personal rights and generally applicable laws, incite to conflict on national, religious, social, as well as any behavior that violates social and moral norms.
13. It is forbidden to damage, destroy or steal elements standing in the event area.
14. The Organizer's security services and municipal security services have the right to remove persons violating the provisions of the Regulations from the event area or take other appropriate actions to stop the violation of the provisions of the Regulations.
15. The event area is constantly monitored. In the event of noticing a threat, persons using the installation should:
  - a. immediately notify security or information services about the threat:

- a. comply with information orders, messages issued by security and information services,
- b. do not impede the access of emergency services.
